ILL (Inter-Library Loan)

Each reader enrolled benefits from the Inter-Library Loan. If the item you are looking for is not held by the BCU, you can submit a loan request from another French or foreign library. This service is supplied free of charge for the members of UCAA. It is performed from Clermont-Ferrand. Aurillac acts as an intermediary as a result.



IBL (Inter-Branch Loan)

Each reader enrolled benefits from the Inter-Branch Loan: the readers who live in Aurillac can submit a loan request for free from another University library of the BCU network.

Règle de vie et consignes de sécurité

Any person who would refuse to obey the rules and who would disturb the peace would immediately be asked to leave the library. In the event of renewed breaches, the Library Director shall decide on the exclusion from the library.

Any reader has the duty to respect both the other patrons and the library staff. Any person whose behavior

seems to be detrimental to both the other patrons and the staff, may be banned from accessing the building for a short while or permanently.

Library access is prohibited for domestic animals, except for the dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. The readers cannot enter the premises of the library with, or using wheeled devices such as skateboards, roller-skates, scooters or bicycles.

Any damage to the premises, the furniture and computer hardware, beyond repair will be replaced at the expense of the patron. This damage will result in a penalty. Eating, drinking, speaking aloud, conducting propaganda, and smoking is prohibited in the library. Cell phones must be shut off. It is prohibited to display outside of the boards reserved for that purpose. Any posting is subject to authorization.
