LIBRARY RULES AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Any person refusing to abide by the rules will be asked to leave the library. In case of a repeated offense, users can be banned from the library's premises.

Animals are prohibited from entering the library, with the exception of dogs accompanying disabled people. Users cannot enter the premises of the library on rollerblades, on a scooter or a bicycle. Any damage to premises, furniture and computer equipment will entail replacement costs.

It is forbidden to eat, drink, speak aloud, or to engage in propaganda within the library. The library is a smoke-free area.

Cell phones should be turned off.

It is forbidden to put up posters without authorization, or outside the panels dedicated to this purpose.

INTER-LIBRARY LOAN (PEB)

Certain items held at outlying UCA sites can be requested to be transferred from one site to another for loan, free of charge for UCA and UC2A members.
